Safety Rules and Display Guidelines

Presentations and displays on exhibit at the science fair **may not include the following items:**

Live animals. If your project involves animals (mice in a maze, for example), include photos of the animals in the project display rather than bringing the actual animal to the event.

Liquids other than water, kitchen items, or non-toxic household cleaners.

Dry ice.

Open flames or highly flammable materials. Any equipment producing heat capable of causing physical burns (such as a heating plate) must be adequately insulated to prevent injury.

Batteries with open-top cells.

Pressurized tanks.

Lasers.

Knives, needles, or other sharp items.

Any other item or apparatus deemed unsafe, offensive, or inappropriate by Ingalls Memorial Library staff and trustees.

Folding tables will be set up in the Meeting House for the fair, with each student/student team allocated a section of table approximately 36 inches wide for that student's/team's display. See the registration form for a description of what the panel of judges will be looking for in the presentations in the two categories: "Level One: Demonstration Projects" and "Level Two: Experiments."
